

Mini Bunting

This bunting is a cute and fun project, great for stash busting. Perfect for dressing up the bedroom window, decorations for a party, or just for fun!

This project requires intermediate knitting knowledge (casting on, knit stitch, purl stitch, binding off, and increasing) and basic crocheting knowledge (chaining and slip stitches), making it a fun and quick project.



Materials:

Worsted weight yarn in two different colors (written in the pattern as "color A" and "color B").

Size 10 knitting needles

Size G crochet hook

To Make:

Cast on 2 sts.

Row 1: [K1,m1] two times.

Row 2 and all even numbered rows: Purl across

Rows 3, 5, and 7: K1, m1, knit to last stitch, k1, m1.

Bind off loosely.

Make 12 triangles with color A.

With the crochet hook and color B, chain 20, slip stitch across each stitch of a color A triangle.

Chain 6.

Slip stitch across each triangle.

Chain 20 and cut yarn.

Weave in all ends.
